### What is Flying8 ?

Flying8 is weaving loom and weaving process, method and technology.

Flying8 was developed by Andreas Möller.

He has been weaving for over 40 years and has always found, invented and tested improvements that simplify weaving and the loom.

### Flying8 puts the weaving person in the center.

The loom is ergonomic, quiet, light and has good lighting. The weaving method is clear, uncomplicated, brisk and modern. The loom and accessories do not have to be expensive, everything can be built by yourself.

### For whom is Flying8 weaving interesting?

Beginners and professionals alike will benefit.

Anyone who has always wanted to weave but didn't start: "Too noisy, too big, too expensive, too difficult, too tedious!", that's over! Now you can get started!

Flying8 looms are in use at universities, weaving mills and living rooms all over the world.

### What is the difference between Flying8 and conventional weaving?

A Flying8 loom uses much less resources and less space than comparable normal looms.

Noise is greatly reduced and the loom is adjustable to the size of the user. Setting up the loom and weaving can be done alone in a very comfortable posture in quite a short time.

### What will I learn in a 6-day Flying8 weaving course?

This course will put you on the right path to understanding weaving practically and theoretically.

From thread to fabric, all the moves are taught, learned and completed several times.

You will prepare warps with the Flying8 lift system, put them on the loom with the "best friend". You learn to build bobbins and to wind the weft thread properly on them.

Pattern formation will first be gone through theoretically and then practically applied in the Flying8 loom.

You will weave samples and products.

Do you already have experience? Then more advanced content can also be discussed beforehand. The goal is that you can confidently use your new skills and knowledge in your loom at home.
